It's hard to believe that the Summer Term is here already and I trust that you have enjoyed the Spring break. School will open again tomorrow morning with the first class starting at 8.30am. I look forward to seeing you on the playground tomorrow morning.

PE Kits

PE will be outside as often as possible. Children have been advised that if they want to wear a tracksuit over their PE kits then they can do so. Previously, this was only children in Y3-Y6 but has now been increased to Y1 & Y2 also due to the increase in outdoor lessons. Please ensure that all children have at least their normal PE kit in straight away. Please note that Y3 children will now have PE on a Tuesday afternoon and Y4 will now have PE on a Wednesday. The first lesson for Y3 is tomorrow (Tuesday 13th April).

Summer Uniform

Summer uniform can be worn from this point onwards if you should choose for your child to do so. We appreciate that it is still cold though and many children will continue to wear their Autumn/Winter uniform for the time being. Summer uniform consists of a white polo shirt, grey trousers/shorts or a red and white gingham dress/playsuit (some younger children sometimes struggle to access the toilet when wearing playsuits). School jumpers and cardigans are still to be worn. Black/dark shoes or dark/white closed toe sandals can be worn but please no open toe sandals, boots or trainers.

Ocean Blue T-shirts

We are planning another Ocean Blue environmental day on Thursday 22nd April. This is Earth Day and we are asking all children to wear their Ocean Blue T-shirts on that day. We first used the t-shirts 2 years ago and as a result many of the children may have outgrown their t-shirts. In keeping with our eco and recycling approach, you can send your old t-shirts into school, we will clean and redistribute them to other children. Mrs Bolton is also organising more t-shirts that can be bought after school. More details of this will follow in the coming days.
