I hope you are all well in what is a very strange and challenging time for us all. The school staff have continued to work right through since the last day we were all together in school. The teaching and learning staff have been setting work and responding regularly to the children on Google Classroom. They have also been working on a rotation basis providing emergency childcare for the children of key workers, many of whom are NHS staff working on the frontline facing the challenge posed by COVID 19. The cleaning staff have been working so hard to ensure that the school is consistently deep cleaned and the office staff are still working remotely each day. ### Assessment for Grammar School Education (11+)

Parents of children currently in Y5 who wish for their child to be assessed for non-Catholic grammar schools must register their interests between 1<sup>st</sup> May and 31<sup>st</sup> May. To do this, visit <a href="www.wirral.gov.uk/schooladmissions">www.wirral.gov.uk/schooladmissions</a>. At the present moment, all arrangements made for the assessments are expected to go ahead as planned on Monday 21<sup>st</sup> September 2020. Should there be any change to the arrangements due to guidance including social distancing, you will be notified at the earliest opportunity. No arrangements will be made to assess children if the forms are not received by 31<sup>st</sup> May unless they have recently moved to Wirral from another part of the country.
