Beehive- Wrap Around Care at Heswall

A reminder that the school wrap around is open and still going strong. Run by Beth Hallsworth and her super team, we offer Wrap around for children aged 3-11 each school day. The morning session runs from 7.30am until the class starts and in the evening until 6pm. We provide a selection of breakfasts each morning and a warm snack each evening. Current costs are £5 for each morning session and £8.50 each evening. We accept all childcare vouchers that are provided by employers including Childcare Choices, Busy Bees, Care-4, Computershare and KiddiVouchers. Just a reminder that all parents' evening appointments will be held on the telephone. All year groups are open for bookings now apart from Year 1 and Year 3 as they have held their telephone appointments this week. If you can keep hold of the login and password for the website to book the appointments for all future appointments, it will save you time over the coming years. We strongly advise you to download the eSchools app as soon as you can and use the information to register. This will ensure that you can receive text notifications, newsletters, and the ability to view your child's attendance record. It will speed up future parents' meeting bookings. In order for the school to be able to send text alerts, we would need the vast majority of parents to download the app. Please ensure you click to allow notifications. Pre-school children are not currently on the app.
