Deputy Headteacher News

Our Deputy Headteacher for the past seven years, Mrs Bolton, has been appointed as the headteacher of Tattenhall Park Primary School in Cheshire. We will be very sad to see Mrs Bolton go as she has been a huge part of making the school the successful place that it is today. Mrs Bolton began her deputy headship in September 2016 after moving to Heswall from Overleigh St Mary's Church of England Primary School in Chester. Since then, we have worked side by side on a daily basis to create a unique curriculum and a strong caring ethos. She has also been responsible for bringing some big events to Heswall Primary including Science under the Stars and has been responsible for our eco films.

Mrs Bolton will remain at Heswall Primary as Deputy Headteacher until Christmas and will begin her new post in January 2024. With the support of the Governing Body, I have immediately started the process to secure the Year 3 class a new teacher and aim to have a seamless transition for the children for January. We have also immediately begun the process for appointing a new senior leader for Heswall Primary School.

We are delighted that we have been able to give Mrs Bolton the platform to develop as a leader to the point that she is ready to lead her own school. She is a very special teacher and an amazing person and we wish her the very best as she moves into her first headship.
