This is to remind us that when we tell ourselves that we can't do something - we should add the word 'Yet! Successful schools balance the right amount of challenge with social and emotional health. We know that 'happy children achieve excellent things!' I am intending to run a parent workshop on Growth Mindset in the new year so you can learn more about our approach.
